Validata™ is ready to receive January 2024 extracts

If your December 2023 extract has been submitted to Validata[™], you can now upload and submit your January 2024 extract. Please remember to submit your extract once it has been validated and contains zero critical errors.

2. The question mark symbol is on every page and tab in SHIP. It provides a stepby-step guide on how to enter data in SHIP. This link also contains information about frequently asked questions on SHIP.
